



The instrument being used to perform the radon survey of the dwelling referenced below has been approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for conducting radon measurements. The operator will conduct a radon survey according to protocols designed for use in residences, as described in the EPA document "*Home Buyer's and Seller's Guide to Radon*". These guidelines were developed specifically to deal with the time-sensitive nature of home purchases and sales.

The EPA requires that radon measurements conducted for real estate transactions be performed using tamper detection techniques. **Be alerted that the device and methods used include the ability to detect certain kinds of test interference.** At his discretion, the tester may nullify the test results if it appears that, in his professional judgment, the results are unreliable due to the suspicion of tampering with the device or the environment. **Occupant/home owner may be responsible for the cost of re-testing.**
